

5 Tips for Sydney Lawn and Turf Maintenance

Do you want to keep the artificial turf immaculate? Then, you need to put more effort into its care and maintenance. These efforts ensure its inviting appearance and enhance longevity. Here are five tips that will help you maintain artificial grass. So, read on!



Clean Stains Promptly

Be prompt to clean stains to ensure they do not leave stubborn stains. Use a paper towel to soak the liquid stains of cola, tea, coffee, alcohol, and wine. Then, rinse the area with hot water, soap, and sponge. But, if you need a stronger stain remover, use 3% ammonia in the water to make it more effective for stains.

Remove Debris and Dirt Away Regularly

In addition to cleaning stains properly, follow a routine of removing leaf litter and dirt to maintain the quality and longevity of Sydney Lawn and Turf. But, if debris and dirt accumulate, they may block the drainage system and cause bacteria to thrive. Hence, brush away dirt or debris once a week after the Autumn season.

Also, follow this practice as needed at other times of the year. A leaf blower may also work for this purpose. Additionally, by trimming overhanging trees, you can reduce debris in the lawn. Remember that artificial turf can last 20-25 years. But, you should pay attention to care and maintenance.

Deal with Pet Waste Instantly

Next, you should immediately deal with pet waste. Dealing with pet waste does not mean rinsing and cleaning Sydney Lawn and Turf. It simply means to remove their solid waste from the grass. However, pet waste stains on the turf are removable. But, you should be more vigilant and put more effort into keeping the lawn area hygienic and pristine from the pets' muddy paws and waste.

Rinse Artificial Turf Periodically

Unlike real grass, artificial grass needs much more attention if you want to keep it looking at its best. Hence, use a garden hose to rinse the grass with the solution of hot water and soap. Otherwise, the collected pollen, pollutants, debris, and seeds on the grass can boost the growth of insects and weeds.

Cross Brush Your Artificial Grass

Cross-brushing is a vital process to keep turf looking pristine and long-lasting. This is the process of brushing turf against the direction of blades to prevent them from becoming matted. This way, it boosts the appearance of the artificial grass cushioned and welcoming. So, do more brushing in those areas that attract more leaf litter, dirt, waste, and other things to keep them looking pristine.

Wrapped It Up

Remember that weeds can also grow on the artificial turf. Hence, install a weed barrier to avoid the situation. But, if you have pets, it is not a solution. In this case, you should gently remove the weeds by hand.
