Postgraduate Degree	AUD 22,000 - 50,000
Doctoral Degree	AUD 18,000 - 42,000
Vocational Education and Training	AUD 4,000 - 22,000

Cost of Living in Australia

On average, the cost of living in Australia comprises accommodation, transport, food, and entertainment. It normally comes to around 20,000 USD per annum. However, the cost differs from place to place. Below is the cost of living in Australia for international students.

Accommodation Type	Expenses
Rental	\$185 - \$440 per week
Shared Rentals	\$95 - \$215 per week
Guesthouses and Hostels	\$90 - \$150 per week

Homestay	\$235 - \$325 per week
Boarding schools	\$11,000 - \$22,000 a year
On-campus	\$110 - \$210 per week

Some Other Extra Costs

- Books and other study materials: between 500 - 1,000 AUD/year
- Health insurance: rates start at 30 AUD/month
