Rajasthan: Earlier, Rajasthan was leading in the field of milk production, but now it comes second in the list of top 10 milk-producing states in India. It makes up around 14.45% or 33.31 million tonnes of India's total milk production.

Madhya Pradesh: Madhya Pradesh ranks third in the milk production in India. Animal husbandry is considered to be the main reason behind milk production here. 20.12 million tonnes of milk is produced in this state.

Gujarat: In the field of milk production in India, Gujarat is believed to have maintained its fourth position in the country.

Andhra Pradesh: Andhra Pradesh is one of the leading milk-producing states in India, producing 15.45 million tonnes, which accounts for 6.70% of the total milk production.

Maharashtra: Maharashtra ranks sixth in the milk production in India. The total milk production is 15.04 million tonnes, with a share of 6.52%.

Punjab: The total milk produced by Punjab is 14.30 million tonnes. It makes up 6.20% of the total milk production in India.

Karnataka: Karnataka's total milk production was 12.83 million tonnes, accounting for 5.56%. The total number of cows and buffaloes in Karnataka in 2019 was 5.73 million.

Bihar: Bihar is an agricultural state, hence it has a large base of agriculture and animal husbandry. Milk production of Bihar in 2022-23 was 12.50 million tonnes and was 5.42% of the total milk produced in India.

Haryana: The availability of milk and the number of milk-producing animals are continuously increasing in Haryana. Milk production of Haryana is expected to reach 11.97 million tonnes in 2022-23.
