While these are the average tuition fees of the different degree types in the country. Still, the exact fee may vary depending on the institute. In graduate programs, MBA fees in USA can be

more along with professional degrees like law, medicine, dentistry and design. Also, most doctoral degrees are 100% funded through teaching assistantships, bursaries and scholarships. Mostly, humanities and art courses are cheaper in the country. The tuition fee for the postgraduate level is typically more than for undergraduate and foundation-level programs.

Private Universities vs Public Universities - Tuition Fees

Public universities in USA are funded by the state government. In the USA, a master's degree programme typically costs \$25,000 per year at public colleges and \$41,000 per year at private universities. These expenses may change annually. The average annual tuition fees for some private and public universities in USA are listed in the table below, along with how they affect the cost of living in the USA.
