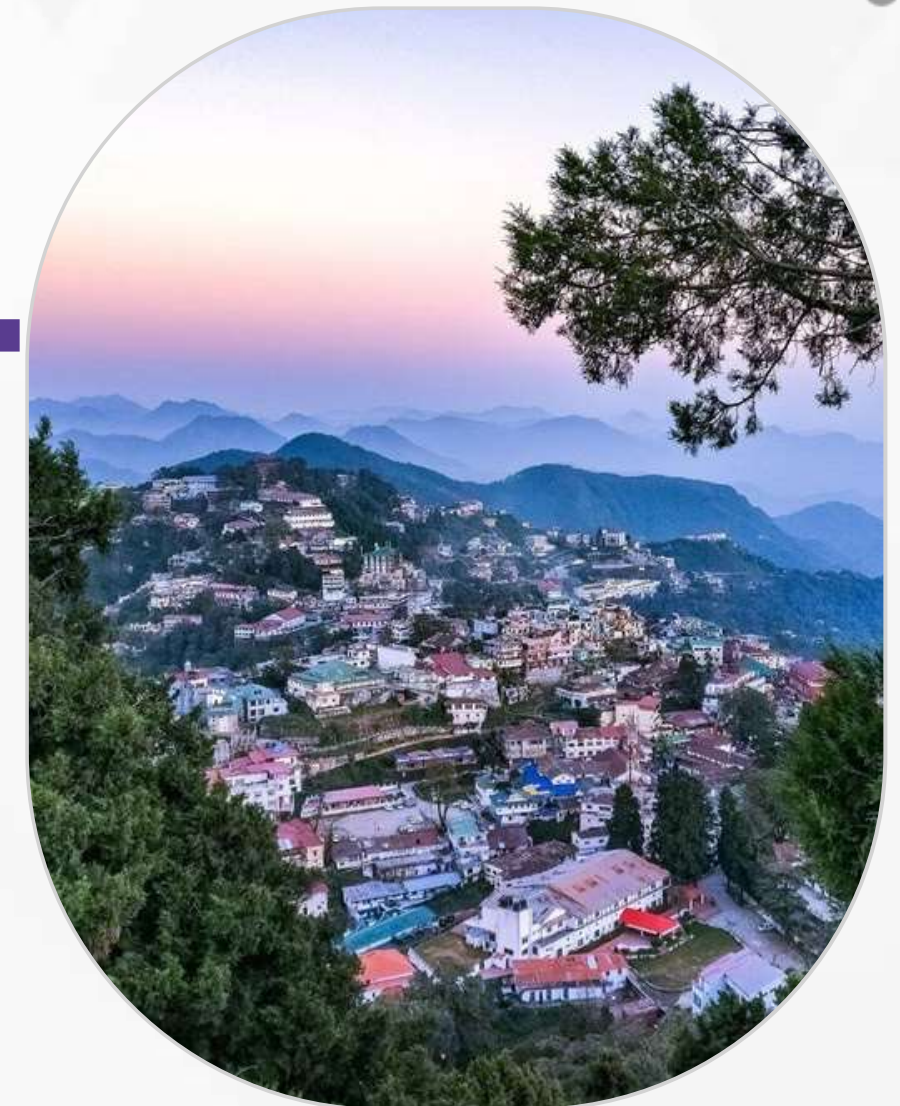

2. NAINA DEVI TEMPLE

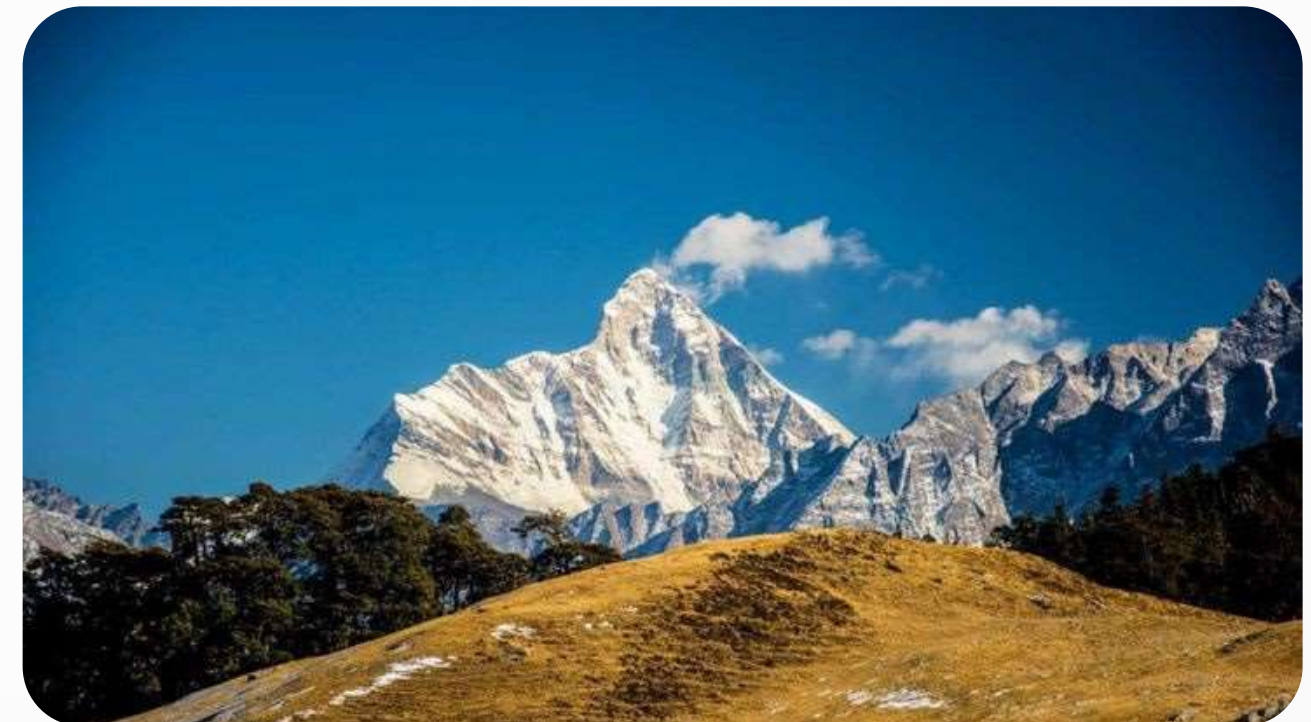
Visit the Naina Devi Temple situated on the northern bank of Naini Lake.

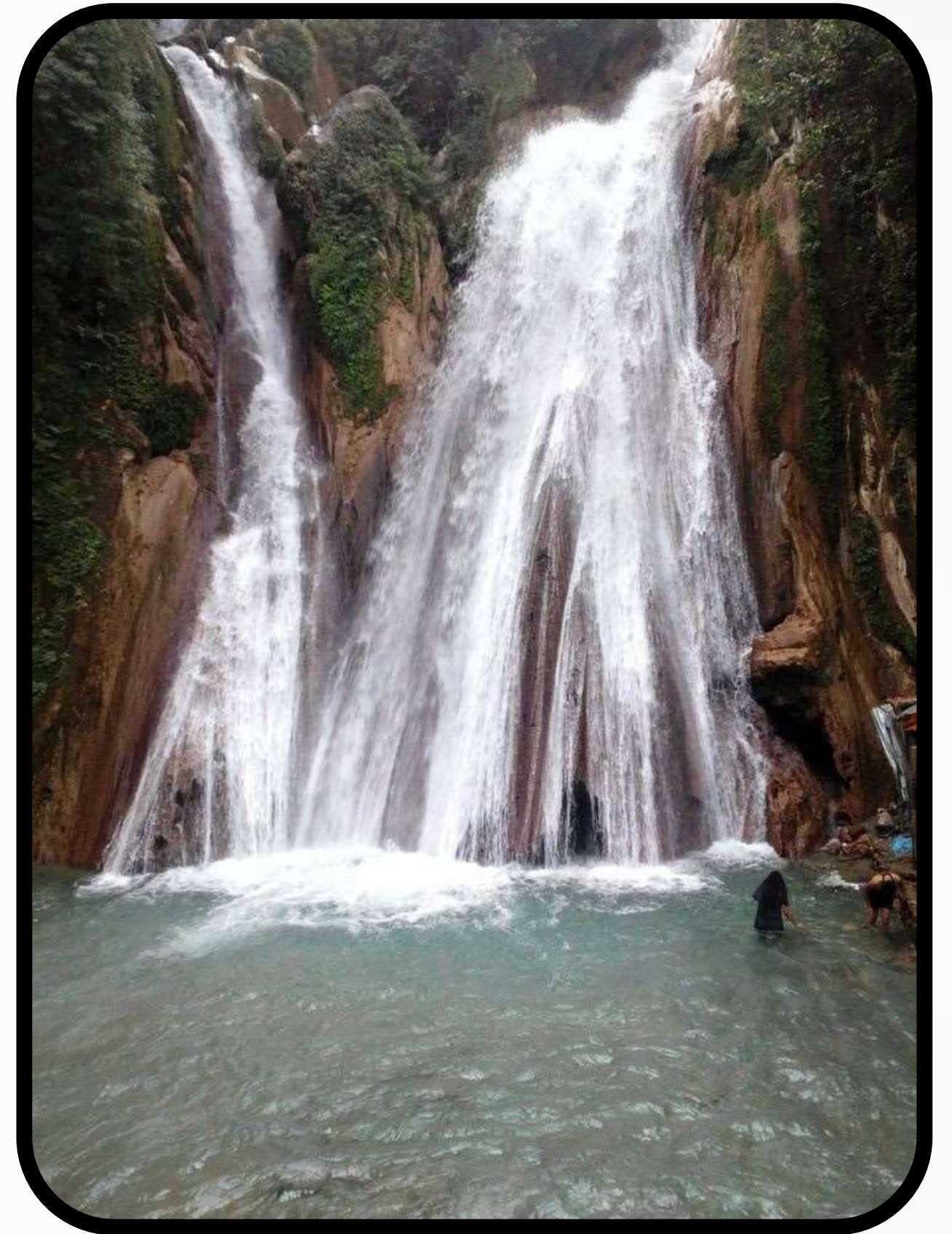
5. TIFFIN TOP

MUSSOORIE

1. KEMPTY FALLS

Start your Mussoorie exploration with a visit to Kempty Falls, a popular waterfall where you can enjoy a refreshing dip or just soak in the natural beauty. 2. GUN HILL

Take a cable car ride or trek to Gun Hill, the second-highest peak in Mussoorie. The name "Gun Hill" originated from the colonial practice of firing a cannon at noon to help people adjust their watches. The panoramic views of the Himalayas from here are amazing, especially during sunrise and sunset.

3. CAMEL'S BACK ROAD

Enjoy a leisurely walk on Camel's Back Road, named after a rock formation that looks like a camel's hump. Lined with deodar trees and offering breathtaking views of the Himalayas, it's a popular walking trail. This road offers beautiful views of the mountains.



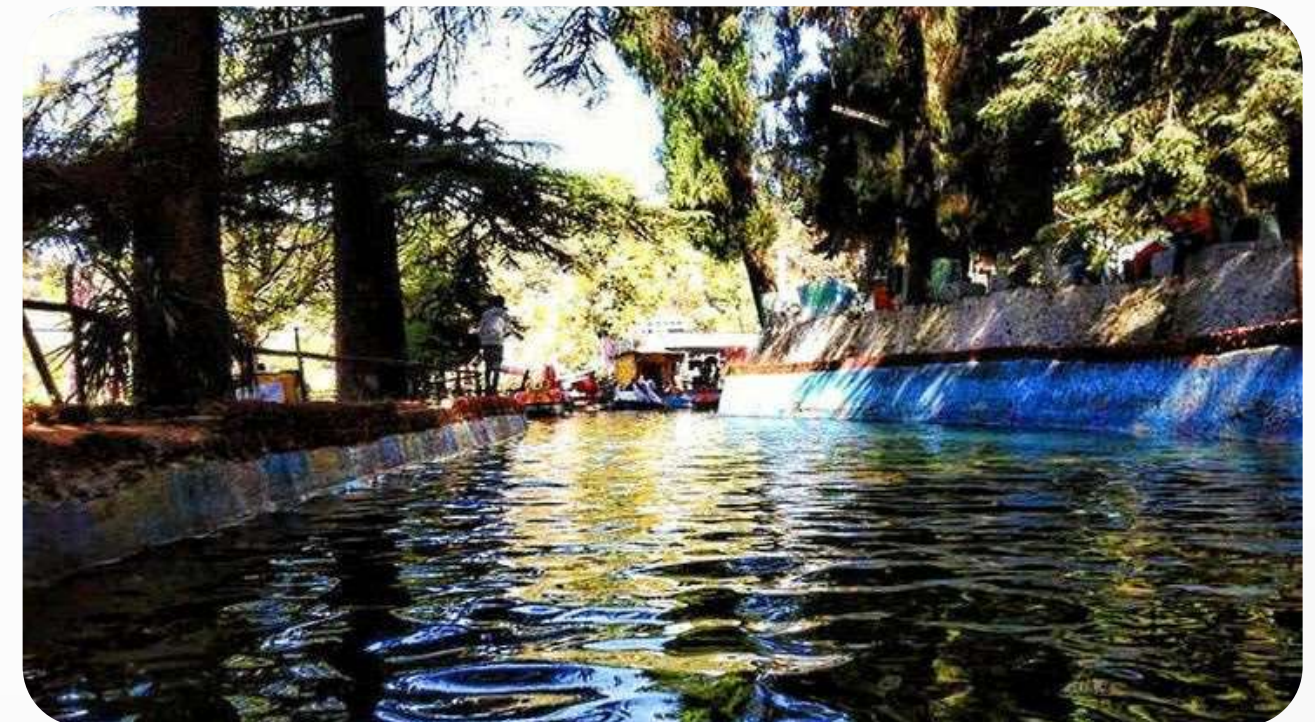
4. LAL TIBBA

Visit Lal Tibba, the highest point in Mussoorie, for breathtaking views of the snow-capped Himalayas. The literal translation of Lal Tibba is "Red Hill," named after the British depot installed here. At an altitude of 2,275 meters, it provides a stunning vantage point for observing the snow-capped peaks, including Badrinath and Kedarnath. Lal Tibba attracts tourists with its tranquil atmosphere, pleasant weather, and the opportunity to witness spectacular sunrise and sunset vistas.



5. MUSSOORIE LAKE

Spend some relaxing time at the Mussoorie Lake surrounded by lush greenery. Boating facilities are available, and it is an ideal place for a picnic.
