
Pre-Construction Termite Treatment and its Benefits



Those who have encountered termites know how tormenting they can be. It is not because they spread diseases, because they don't. They are tormenting us because slowly and stealthily they destroy our home from the inside. They feed on wood and they will devour anything made of wood from the inside. You won't know about the damage until you have an inspection from professional <u>termite control services in Bhubaneswar</u> or there are some visible signs of the damage.

If you are about to build a new home, it can be a golden opportunity to make your future home termite-free. Do not wait for termites to attack your home and then control it, instead, the best way to prevent termites is to get preconstruction **anti-termite treatment in Bhubaneswar**. It is something every new homeowner should do, to protect their new building and other wooden structures from termite damage.

Process of Pre-Construction Termite Treatment

The process of pre and post-construction termite control is entirely different. If you want to prevent your house from termites, it is better to go for pre-construction treatment. Here are the procedures:

Step-1:

The first step to do a pre-construction termite treatment is to treat the foundation with an anti-termite solution or termiticides. This is because termites generally enter your building through the foundation by making mud tunnels in the walls. So, termiticides are poured into the sides and the bottom surface of the foundation.

• Step-2:

In the second step, the soil around the foundation is treated. Liquid termiticides are applied to the soil around the foundation to create a barrier for the termites, which will block the termites from reaching the foundation area. Not only this will secure the foundation from termites but also protect your house from future termite attacks.

• Step-3:

In this step, the consolidated earth within the plinth walls is treated with liquid termiticides.

• Step-4:

In the final step, the soil around the pipes, gutter, and tubes that run into the foundation is treated with termiticides. The soil around each entry point is loosened around each pipe and tube, and then treated with liquid termiticides.

The pre-construction termite treatment is very simple as compared to post-construction treatments. But, as simple as these steps are, they shouldn't be tried by everyone and only a professional from **pest control services in Bhubaneswar** should be appointed to carry out these steps. You may be skeptical about hiring professionals as they will cost you money, but the way they treat the foundation will ensure the risk of termites attacking your foundation is minimized.

Benefits of Pre-Construction Termite Treatment

Here are the benefits that will assure you why pre-construction termite treatment by a professional pest control service is better than post-construction:

Less Cost:

The cost of pre-construction is always low than those of post-construction treatments. The reason is, there are fewer steps involved in pre-construction than those done after the house is built. So, when the steps are lessened, the cost will also be less.

• Fewer Barriers:

The barriers or obstacles in a pre-construction are fewer than those in post-construction. A professional exterminator will have absolutely no barriers such as walls while treating for termites in the crucial areas in pre-construction. This will result in maximum coverage of the area with complete treatment. But, when you have an already built building, you might not get full access to treat the affected areas properly, as you will have plenty of obstacles and won't be able to smoothly cover the whole area.

It is better to Prevent than Cure:

We have all heard the phrase "prevention is better than cure" and it applies to termite treatment too. When you do a post-construction termite treatment, it will be probably too late. Termite infestation is not easily noticeable. When you realize you have a termite infestation, there would have been some harsh damage to the building's foundation and other wooden fixtures. When you do a pre-construction termite treatment, it will eliminate the existing termites that have done no damage whatsoever and prevent your new home from any kind of future infestation.

The benefits of pre-construction are far more useful than those of post-construction. It will protect your home from termite attacks right from the start and foundation. Having learned the benefits, now you must be convinced about going for a <u>pre-construction termite treatment</u>, rather than get a professional after there is termite damage and infestation.
