Admission Requirements

One of the most crucial aspects of your study abroad endeavour is meeting the entrance standards or qualifying criteria. These specifications vary by universities, programmes, and subject areas. Common documents required include academic transcripts, English proficiency test scores, a valid passport, CV, previous education degree, statement of purpose, etc.

Intakes in USA

There are two major intakes in USA, the Spring intake, also known as the January intake, and the fall intake, also called the August intake. The fall intake is the primary intake, and the Spring intake is the second main intake in the USA. Apart from these two intakes, only some universities offer admissions in May or the Summer intake. Only a handful of courses are offered in the summer intake. These two main intakes offer students a chance to enrol in any of these intakes, depending on their course availability. Applying at least 5-6 months before the semester starts is highly recommended. It allows time to focus on the applications. The application dates will vary depending on the subject and university.

Cost of Studying in USA for Indian Students

The cost of studying in USA for Indian students is typically considered to be high. But the reward of a prestigious degree makes it all worth it. Pursuing undergraduate degrees are costlier compared to postgraduate. The cost largely depends on the study area and the university. A degree in the USA might cost you somewhere between \$12,000 to \$75,000.

Cost of Living in USA for Indian Students

As an international student, you need approximately \$700 - \$1500 monthly to cover all your accommodation, groceries, bills, etc. This totals up to \$8,000 - \$18,000 per year. Student Visa Requirements for USA

To study in USA, you need a student visa. Once you receive an offer letter from a university, an I-20 form is sent, which contains all your details. Upon receiving this, you also have to pay your SEVIS fees. SEVIS ID is present on the I-20 form. Once you do this, you have to access your SEVIS ID present on the I-20 form and pay the SEVIS fee. After doing this, only you can book your visa interview slots. The whole process is of two days, for biometrics and the interview, respectively.

The general requirements of US Student Visa are:

- A Valid Passport
- I-20 Form
- Proof of Acceptance by the University
- Proof of Financial Stability
- Confirmation Page of DS-160
- Confirmation of Appointment
- Academic and Professional Documents
- SEVIS Fee Confirmation
